Ms. Rooney asks that whatever comes the community “assume best intentions and seek to understand” on professionalism, fixing structures, having transparency, face-to-face conversations, and support for teachers and students going forward.

X. Voting and discussion

- Vote - Motion: How many positions on SAC to move forward with 7, 8 or 9? Motion for (9) SAC positions going forward was voted on. All 8 voting SAC members agreed to a 9-member SAC commission. This was to reduce from 10 to 9 while aligning with archdiocese best practices and new bylaws asking for membership to be between 7-9.
- Vote - Motion: SAC removes a non-attending member. 7 SAC members vote affirmative, 1 abstains. Motion carries to remove non-attending SAC member and create an additional opening on SAC.
- Vote - Motion: Voting on SAC members for discernment done through paper ballot. Results tabulated and chair to inform all six prospective members of results. Prospective members approved Kathryn Fitzpatrick, Jessica Allen, Dodi David, Rey Rudolf, and Nikki Scully. Slate of approved members sent to Fr. Dennis for final approval.
