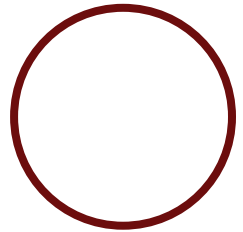
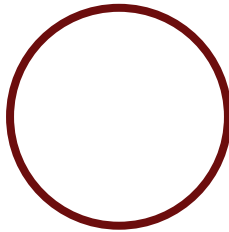
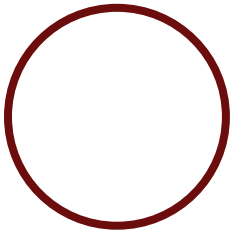
*Draw a heart around the free gift that God gives us.*
