These upgrades will make this space even more beautiful and functional for worship, weddings, and funerals. The Chapel will be closed from mid-February until May during renovations.

Main Campus

A contract is in place for Phase 1 work to develop new parking and to do necessary utility work. This will begin very soon after a city permit is issued. The Building Committee is meeting with the architect team for a review of Phase 2 design documents and cost estimates. The goal is to have final design documents by early February.
