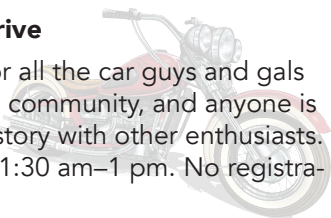


GriefShare: Surviving the Holidays **Wednesday, October 15 at 6:15 pm | Main Campus Room 201**
