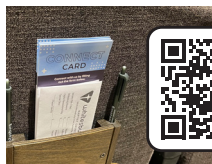

## Pastoral Care Ministry Volunteer Opportunities

The pastoral care ministry is looking for couples or individuals to volunteer with the homebound meals and Noteworthy ministries.

### Homebound meals:

On Tuesdays and Thursdays, the church prepares boxed meals for delivery to our mem-

bers who are homebound. Volunteers are given a mapped-out route that takes approximately an hour to complete. This ministry is a great opportunity to connect with a member who you wouldn't see on a Sunday morning, fulfilling a practical need in their life. Volunteers may commit to one or more delivery routes per month, or to serve as a sub on an as-needed basis.



### Noteworthy:

Each month, the Noteworthy ministry prepares and sends a handwritten card to our widowed and homebound members. WBC provides the cards, labels, and postage for volunteers to prepare handwritten notes which they mail to assigned recipients. In the age of technology, handwritten notes are a special way to reach out and connect with someone to let them know you are thinking and praying for them.

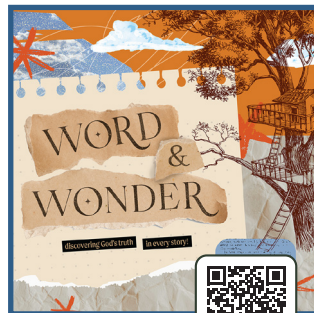
