Romans 1:8-13

First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, because your faith is being proclaimed throughout the whole world. For God, whom I serve in my spirit in the preaching of the gospel of His Son, is my witness as to how unceasingly I make mention of you, always in my prayers making request, if perhaps now at last by the will of God I may succeed in coming to you. For I long to see you so that I may impart some spiritual gift to you, that you may be established; that is, that I may be encouraged together with you while among you, each of us by the other's faith, both yours and mine. I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that often I have planned to come to you (and have been prevented so far) so that I may obtain some fruit among you also, even as among the rest of the Gentiles. We live set apart when we have:

1. Priority in Prayer (verses 8-10)

2. Proclamation of a Public Faith (verse 8)

Philippians 1:27; Matthew 7:20

3. Power of Spiritual Growth (verses 11-12)

Proverbs 27:7; Acts 2:42-47; Hebrews 10:24-25

4. Pursuit of the Lost (verse 13)

Matthew 9:37-38; Luke 19:10; 1 Corinthians 15:21; Romans 10:9-15

The word "Beautiful" in Romans 10:15 is the Greek word *hōraios*. Defined as, timely, lovely, or beautiful.

If we really believe this gospel, it changes everything about how we live!
