Men's Ministry Skeet Shoot


Friday, April 19 | 3 – 8 pm Sharon Johnston Park

MASTER CAMPUS PLAN UPDATE Main Campus

The stormwater detention system under the new parking area is in place. New sanitary sewer pipes and a manhole have been placed. This will result in a minor traffic diversion for cars traveling along the north driveway and the temporary loss of several handicap parking spaces near Entrance 9.

Phase 1 project completion is anticipated by the end of May 2024. The Phase 2 Student and Senior Adult Multipurpose Building addition is currently in the bidding process with construction anticipated to begin in June 2024.

Change is happening and we are looking forward to seeing what God has in store for our church family! Please feel free to dress comfortably for church services and wear sturdy footwear to navigate the parking lots during the renovation process.
