Master Campus Plan Update: Main Campus

The stormwater detention system under the new parking area is in place. New sanitary sewer pipes and a manhole have been placed.

This will result in a minor traffic diversion for cars traveling along the north driveway and the temporary loss of several handicap parking spaces near Entrance 9.

The aggregate base of the new Phase 1 parking area has been laid, and Phase 1 completion is anticipated by the end of May. The Phase 2 Student and Senior Adult Multipurpose Building is currently in the bidding process with construction anticipated to begin in June 2024.
