In the May 2020 edition of "The Atlantic", David Brooks wrote an article entitled, "THE NUCLEAR FAMILY WAS A MISTAKE." He went on to say, "The family structure we've held up as the cultural ideal for the past half century has been a catastrophe for many. It's time to figure out better ways to live together." The word "family" has either been maligned or re-defined in our current culture. Words like, *patriarchy* and *masculinity* are often used to create a negative image of what has often been called the "traditional family."
