# What Does Easter Mean, To Me, Today?

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. 1 Peter 1:3 (NASB95)

Every year, we celebrate Easter! The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead! For many, Easter is an event on a calendar, for Christians, the resurrection is much more. Writing to the early church, Peter begins with an introduction (1 Peter 1:1-2) and suddenly bursts forth with a powerful doxology (hymn of praise, 1 Peter 1:3-5)! Peter's praise was the overflow from a life impacted by the reality of the resurrection. Peter's letter to the 1st century Christians was a message of great hope. The theme of these verses is "hope", not just any hope but the hope that has its basis in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. My prayer is that your daily life will be impacted by the confident hope that is ours because of the resurrection!

It is a lively hope, that is, not only living, but actively alive, an energizing principle of divine life in the believer, a Christian hopefulness and optimism produced in the believer yielded to the indwelling Holy Spirit. It is both an attitude of expectancy as the Christian looks forward to the inheritance awaiting him in heaven, and a hopefulness of present blessing from God in this life in view of the eternal blessedness of the believer in the next life.<sup>1</sup>

Hope – confident optimism for the future, (Romans 15:13)

Biblical hope is a confident expectation and desire for something good in the future. There is moral certainty in it.
