

Family: The Blessing of Children Sunday, May 5, 2024 Ephesians 6:1-3

God intends every aspect of family to be a picture of the gospel. Whether it's the marriage relationship between a man and a woman, or the relationship between parents and their children, God has provided clear expectations and commands. Previously, in Ephesians 5, Paul reminded us that marriage is to reflect the relationship between Christ and the church. In chapter 6, he instructs children and parents how to reflect Christ in our homes.

Family – "primarily, one man and one woman united in matrimony plus natural or adopted children and, secondarily, any other persons related by blood." Andreas Kostenberger

God's purpose for the family! (Ephesians 5-6; Genesis 1:26-28)

- Expression (of God's glory)
- Dominion (over God's creation)
- Procreation (to fill God's creation)
- Reflection (of the gospel)

God's pattern for children!

Romans 1:28-32 and 2 Timothy 3:1-4 reveal the signs of a culture in demise, "disobedient to parents"

- OBEY - Obedience is an action. (Col. 3:20; Prov. 1:8)
"Obedience is doing what God says, when God says to do it, with the right heart attitude!"
"Obedience is doing what you are told, when you are told to do it, with a happy heart."
HONOR - Honor is an attitude. (Exodus 20:12; Leviticus 19:32; Proverbs 23:22; Matthew 15:3-6)
