Phase 2 Begins June 10

Our contract has been signed, and we're set to begin Phase 2 construction on Monday. This will involve demolition of the existing drive-through canopy at the North Lobby entrance, construction of new Student building and Senior Adult Life Group space, and construction of adjacent secondary Senior Adult parking lot.

Anticipated completion is September 2025.

Helpful Construction Information:

- Beginning June 10, the North Lobby (Entrance 9) will be closed until further notice.
- A sidewalk from the parking lot to a small entrance at the north side of the Worship Center will be available.
- Senior adults are encouraged to use the Atrium and South Lobby entrances (Entrances 3 and 5).
- Wheelchair and handicap accessible drop off will be at the South Lobby (Entrance 5) on Sanders Road.
- Please utilize the shuttles and golf carts to assist you from the parking lots.

FLOORING REPLACEMENT



For approximately five weeks this summer, there will be some adjustments to the location of Preschool and Children's classrooms during a carpet and LVT replacement.

Here are a few logistical things to know:

- Work will begin on Monday, June 10, and the first Sunday impacted will be Sunday, June 16.
- Children's area work will occur on weekdays and not affect Sunday.
- Phase 1 work will begin in the Older Preschool area. A plan for Sundays has been formulated to take advantage of the other side of the Atrium to accommodate preschoolers.
- During Phase 2, preschool classes will be shifted into the completed Older Preschool space for the remainder of the project as the Younger Preschool area is improved.
- There will be signage and greeters to assist preschool families each week.
- Child computer check-in will continue to take place at Entrance 3 in the Children's Atrium.
- Drop off and pick up at classrooms will continue to utilize tag checks at each classroom.
- On Wednesdays, Preschool, Children, and Student activities will be held at the South Campus (as well as Hard Questions for adults).
