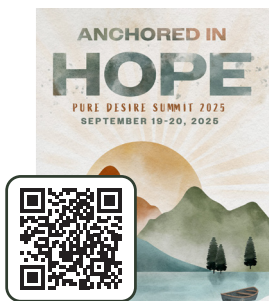

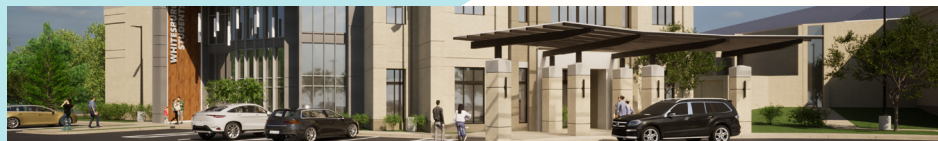
## Pure Desire Conference September 19-20 Whitesburg Baptist: Virtual Host
