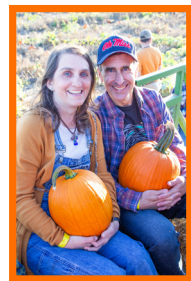


## Workday for New Building

Pre-registration tickets are \$15/person for ages 3 and up and \$20 for walk-up tickets.

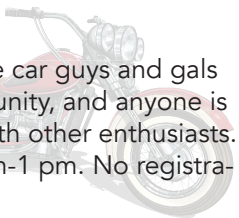


## Cruise In
