

Registrant Information and Instructions

Whitesburg Men's Skeet Shooting Event  
17 April 2026

1. Event Location and Time. This event will be held on 17 April 2026 (24 April if “weathered out” on 17 April) at the Madison County Shooting Sports Association Range Complex located at Gate 4 of the Sharon Johnston Park, 783 Coleman Road, New Market, Alabama. Sign-in begins at the Range Club House beginning at 3 PM with shooting running from 3 PM to 6 PM, a meal following at 6PM and range activities ending beginning at 7 PM.
2. Event Sign-in.
  - a. Upon arrival at the Range Complex, follow the General Instructions as provided in a separate document.
  - b. All shooters report to the Club House to be assisted in signing in.
  - c. Range Rules Exam.
    - 1) If a shooter has previously taken the MCSSA Range Rules Exam, it should be on file in the Club House and no further exam action is required.
    - 2) If you have not previously taken the exam, you must take the “open-book” exam as part of the sign-in procedure.
  - d. Release
    - 1) If you are an MCSSA Member, you will not be required to sign a release.
    - 2) If you are not an MCSSA Member, you will need to sign a release sheet.
    - 3) If a shooter is age 18 or younger, a parent or guardian as well as the youth must sign a release form.
  - e. Range Fees. The MCSSA Member and shooter age 18 and under shooting fee is \$4.00 per 25 rounds shot (one box of shells). The non-member shooting fee is \$7.00 per 25 rounds shot (one box of shells). **Payment may be made with check or cash only. No credit or debit cards can be accepted.**
  - f. Loaner Shotguns. A limited number of loaner shotguns will be available. When signing in, let the sign-in manager know if you need to borrow a shotgun.
  - g. Ammunition. Shooters are strongly encouraged to bring their own ammunition for this event. A very limited amount of 12-gauge and 20-gauge ammunition will be available for purchase at cost. **Payment may be made with check or cash only. No credit or debit cards can be accepted.**
3. Safety and Orientation Briefing. After completing event sign-in inside the Club House:
  - a. Proceed to the gazebo immediately behind the Club House to receive a brief range orientation and safety briefing. Place unloaded shotguns on racks provided nearby.
  - b. Briefer will cover the following:

- 1) Range layout and safety
  - 2) Shotgun safety
  - 3) Shotgun mounting and eye dominance
- c. Following the briefing, 4-shooter groups will be formed and assigned to one of three available Skeet fields. Shooting groups will report to their assigned field with shotguns (unloaded with breach/action open) and ammunition (25 rounds per shooter).
4. Shooting. An experienced Skeet shooter will be in charge of each Skeet field, responsible for overall safety and shooting. Follow this individual's instructions to have a safe and enjoyable experience.
  5. After-Shooting Meal and Fellowship. Following shooting, beginning at 6 PM, a meal will be served. The Range Complex will remain available for meeting and fellowship up until 8 PM.
  6. Other. Target house entrance is restricted to designated MCSSA Members ONLY to load and service target carousels. Shooters are encouraged to lend a hand in policing spent shotgun shells from the Skeet fields and the collection of trash generated during the event. We want to be good stewards of the facility that has been so graciously provided to us for our enjoyment.
