Subject: Please Vote NO on SB26-097

Dear Senator,

I am your constituent, and I respectfully ask you to vote NO on SB26-097, the bill to decriminalize adult commercial sexual activity.

As a Coloradan who cares deeply about the safety and dignity of women, children, and vulnerable people in our state, I am alarmed by the direction this bill would take Colorado.

Extensive international research, along with domestic data from places such as Nevada where prostitution is legal in parts of the state, shows a consistent pattern of increased demand, expanded trafficking, and greater difficulty distinguishing between consensual transactions and coercion. When the commercial sex market grows, exploitation grows with it, especially among vulnerable women and minors.

Colorado should not become the first state in the nation to fully legalize prostitution and risk normalizing the commodification of human beings.

Please stand with women, children, families, and communities across our state by voting NO on SB26-097.
