Special Collection for Access to Mental Health Care (November 18/19, 2023). Every county in the Diocese of Grand Island is identified as a Health Professions Shortage area for Behavioral Health (source: Federal Office of Rural Health Policy). The United Health Foundation's 2021 Annual Report found that almost 17% of Nebraskans experienced symptoms of depression, 12% of adults reported frequent mental distress, and 13% of Nebraska's children faced two or more adverse childhood experiences, yet the number of mental health providers in the entire state is fewer than 2.9 per 1,000 Nebraskans. On November 19th, a special collection will be gathered to support access to mental health care within our diocese. Your donation will help provide assistance for individuals seeking care, increase access to Catholic providers, and develop local mental health ministry programs to offer mentoring and support.
