The Order Friar Servants of Mary (Servites) was started by seven cloth merchants outside Florence, Italy, in 1233. Known as the Seven Holy Founders, canonized in 1888, their Feast Day is February 17. The most well-known Servite Saint is St. Peregrine Laziosi, OSM, patron of those with cancer and life-threatening illness. We began our work in the Viariate of Ingwavuma, Zululand, Natal, South Africa in 1948. Our Servite Mission Appeals support the daily ministry to the Zulu Catholics in the Vicariate, the evangelization of the non-Catholic, and the formation of Servite seminarians. Fr. Paul Gins, OSM, from Chicago will be the homilist this weekend.
