Theme: DIVINELY REST AND COMPLETION

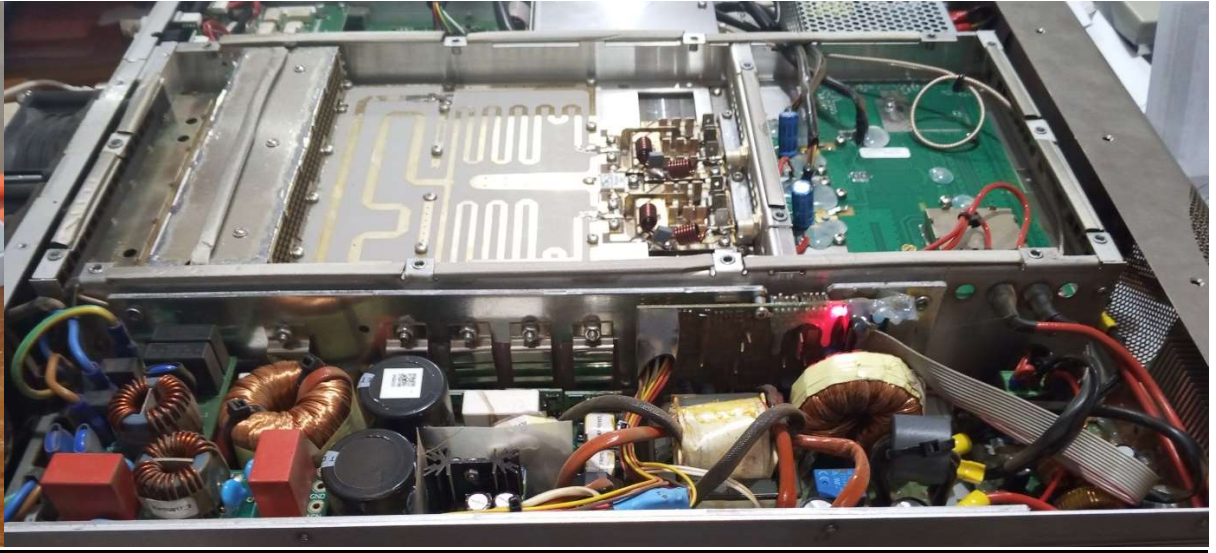
