The mission team made a significant impact by facilitating a church service at Kitale Main Prison, where **nine prisoners found new hope in Christ**.

A friendly football match with the prison's team demonstrated unity and sportsmanship, reinforcing the message of redemption. This reflects the teaching of Hebrews 13:3, "Continue to remember those in prison, as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering."

This day the church had an honor to hold a prayer day service for the candidates who are sitting for their national examinations at the prison, we prayed with them, encouraged them and even shared with them a few sanitary items to help them.
