What are the characteristics of the church and community?

Both the church and the community have experienced growth. The number of families with school-aged children is increasing at a significant level. This demographic is reflected in the growth and development of the Glyndon Christian School, a ministry of the church. The school is adding a kindergarten class, as well as grades 1-5. The church has taken in 10 persons on profession of faith in 2023. In addition, a new member class of 12 is in progress.
