What are the characteristics of the church and community?

Hereford UMC is primarily Caucasian, with some African American presence. This reflects the community. Monkton is a rural community, with a growing suburban identity. There is a strong sense of shared community. Median household income is 134,925. The church is significantly engaged in local missions.

What is the vision for the next 3-5 years?

The vision of the church is focused on bringing people closer to Christ; to deepen discipleship in ways that engage the community, including those who are part of the pre-school. Achieving the vision will involve 1/growing use of technology into a high level of quality and engagement, broadening the church's virtual footprint 2/continuing to create a culture of generosity that would include new ministries and outreach; and 3/continuing to stay current with the mortgage on the Family Life Center and Mission Share responsibilities.

What are the expectations of the pastor?

Preference is for a pastor to live in the community and be active in the community and local church activities, including engagement with the pre-school.

The leadership emphasizes that Hereford UMC (Hereford Faith and Life) is a welcoming place for all people and would hope for a pastor whose values align with the "moderately conservative" congregation.
