LWML Mites

Your mites count! Mite offerings will be collected on the second Sunday of each month or may be turned into the office. Each member of LOL is encouraged to collect their mites as the widow in the Bible, and prayerfully support the mission service projects of the LWML, Lutheran Women in Mission.

The focus for March 2025 is on the LWML grant “Showering Love on the Least of These” benefitting Mercy Holistic Ministry in Sacramento, CA. Through this \$100,000 grant, MHM will be able to increase the frequency of their mobile hot shower services and haircuts from two to three days per week and serve 2,000 more people annually. A mobile clothing trailer will be purchased and operated to give away clean clothing and hygiene kits. God’s Word will be shared by distributing 10 to 15 Bibles and prayer books every week. In the last several years the homeless population in Sacramento has about doubled to 10,000 people. These services will enhance the feeling of worth, provide hope in Jesus, and give counseling to aid the homeless in applying for jobs or securing an apartment. All people are created in God’s image, loved by God in Jesus Christ, and need to experience that love every day in a multitude of ways.


A Life Thought in the Church Year
