

HOW TO GIVE

At the end of January, we will send all the funds we have received to ICR so that they can purchase the Bibles and smuggle them into Iran. According to ICR, "these Bibles will either be taken to the homes of individuals who have directly requested a Bible or given out at house churches to members who can then distribute them among family and friends. Our partners have a team of mature believers who do onthe-ground follow-up work, in partnership with the local church."

BIBLES FOR IRAN

According to Voice of the Martyrs, "more than 97% of Iranians are identified by the government as Muslims, but a significant segment of the population has abandoned Islam, and many have come to faith in Christ." Estimates put the number of believers in Iran at one million or more, and it is ranked as one of the fastest growing church populations in the world.

Converting from Islam or distributing Bibles are both illegal in Iran. With the government cracking down hard, there is a desperate need for God's Word. This Advent season, the funds that we raise for our giving project will go to International Christian Response (ICR) for the purchase of Bibles for the body of Christ in Iran. Each Bible costs \$10.

We'll take a special offering for this at our 6 PM service on Christmas Eve, but you can give any time until the end of January.
