Training for Potential Foster Parents

Led by Matt & Shannon McCaw

Who: This series of classes is for any families, couples or single adults interested in becoming certified foster parents in Deschutes, Crook or Jefferson County. By the end of the series, all training requirements will be complete and the home study process with ODHS will have been started.

What: A nine-week series to support Christians in becoming certified foster parents in Central Oregon.

When: The specific dates are not set yet, but the group will meet one night per week (most likely Sunday evenings) throughout the summer. If there are sessions you cannot attend, videos will be made available to watch.

Where: Most likely in Redmond but the location will be determined based on the number and location of the participants who sign up. Babysitting will be provided if needed.

Why: The need for foster parents in Central Oregon is great! DHS is having to look for homes outside of the area to place children due to the lack of homes. We believe that as Christians, we are called to care for the children in greatest need in the community around us.
