Improvements to the bathrooms and kitchen of the Memorial Hall wing are now complete as we await the arrival of Family Promise of the Jersey Shore over the next 30 days. FPJS will be leasing the space to provide a day center for their staff and the families they serve. Similar to our long history with IFS, FPJS operates a rotational network of churches providing overnight accommodation to families experiencing homelessness in Ocean County. Those families need a space to call home when they are not at a host church, and St. Andrew has stepped forward to fill the need. We will also be joining the FPJS rotational network to continue hosting families overnight on a periodic basis as IFS has changed their model seeking to establish a full-time shelter at their existing facility.
