Trustee News. As you may remember, the Trustees posted an "open letter" to the Church in the August newsletter, making everyone aware of big changes happening and potentially happening in our building. For those that have been to the Church, you have seen the addition of tables into the Sanctuary. We know this is a big change to ask of some of our members that have worshiped in this space for a long time, but the tables have been a popular addition for several of our members. Also, hopefully you have taken note of the efforts to convert the Fellowship Hall into a shared Hall and Pickleball facility. It is expected that no later than September 1, the pickleball courts - to be marketed as "The Serve Center where you serve so we can serve" - will be available to the pickleball community to rent space to play. This is a very exciting effort as it is expected to bring in significant and needed revenue. We also hope that the traffic of players coming onto and into our campus, may result in a Sunday visitor or two as well. Lastly, we mentioned that the Church started the formal process to consider leasing our Memorial Hall and classrooms wing to Family Promise to support their efforts in prevention of family homelessness and housing displaced families. This effort was unanimously approved at the August 6th Charge Conference. We are still working out final Agreement details with Family Promise, but it is expected that work to renovate certain areas of the Memorial Hall wing will start soon and Family Promise will move into the Church in the early Fall. We are all very excited of these changes. They will bring in needful financial resources, expand our connections to helping families in need and bring us all together as one Church body as we worship side by side. If anyone would like to discuss any or all of these changes, please reach out to Pastor Anna. Pastor Anna will arrange a conversation with herself and a trustee or administrative board member. We don't want anyone feeling left out or disconcerted by any or all of these changes. This is your Church and we want everyone to feel connected to it. Trustee News #2. Following the recently held United Women of Faith's Ice Cream Social, we found that the Fellowship Hall kitchen's drain network is blocked up. Initial efforts to relieve the blockage have found that a Code required grease trap under the floor of the kitchen is in disrepair and it is the cause of the problem. This unit need to be replaced. The Trustees are working on the best solution for this problem. In the interim, the large sink and dishwasher are out of service. The smaller sink is unaffected, so light water use is available.
