 - What does this tell you about what type of attention each of these animals receive from people?

 - The Camel represents the issues, no matter how important, that we simply ignore. What are some things in life that the Camel represents?
- With that idea in mind, what do you think that Jesus means by, "You give your tithe but have neglected the more important—justice, mercy, and faithfulness"? (NEPV—Nick Engle Paraphrased Version)
 - Why is tithing such an important act of worship?
 - Does it deserve "gnat" like attention? YES!
 - What makes justice, mercy, and faithfulness more important than the tithe?
 - Which is easier? Tithing or justice, mercy and faithfulness? Why?
