 - Paul makes it seem that living according to the flesh is all evil and bad... Is that true? Why or why not?
 - Paul presents the idea that you can't live both according to the flesh as well as the Spirit. It must be one or the other, not a combination of both. What does this idea look like in real life? Is it possible for us to live fully by the Spirit? Why or why not?
 - According to this passage, what is the evidence of living a life void of the Spirit and only by the flesh? What does this look like in modern times?
 - What is the evidence of living by the Spirit? What does this look like in modern times?
- In his message, Pastor Harry said, "If we walk in the power of the spirit there is sin that we are called away from. We also see that we are called into something better."
 - How have you seen this principle at work in your own life?
 - Pastor Harry also said that the Holy Spirit is the same in everyone. No one has greater access to the Spirit than anyone else. So why does it seem that some live more in the spirit than others?
 - What is the limiting factor of the Holy Spirit in your life if it is not Him?
 - What areas of your life do you need to lean more in the spirit and less in the flesh?
