- What is something that stuck out to you from last Sunday's teaching?
- Everyone Answer: Have you ever been investigated for anything? By family, friends or law enforcement?
 - Was the investigation warranted? Did you do what you were being investigated for?
 - How many people were affected or involved in your investigation?
- Read John 9:1-41
 - In what way is this passage ironic?
 - Describe the investigation that takes place into the blind man. Was it warranted?
 - How is Jesus fulfilling the true purpose of the Sabbath here?
 - The man was *born* blind! Why do you think the disciples thought he had sinned to cause his blindness?
 - How does Jesus answer this question?
- In our time, who does society tell us we should help? Who does society tell us we shouldn't help?
 - Who is it that actually needs help? Is this different than Jesus' day?
 - What do you actively do to help people?
 - How can you help more?
- The truth is that we all need Jesus help somehow.
 - In what ways do people need the help of Jesus?
 - Pastor Dave challenged us all to be praying for someone to invite to Easter services. Who have you been praying for?
- Pray for each other's needs and the people to invite to Easter together.
