Revelation 2:3–5 You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary. ⁴ Yet I hold this against you: <u>You have forsaken the love you had at first</u>. ⁵ Consider how far you have fallen! <u>Repent and do the things you did at first</u>. (NIV)

2. By______in_____.

Revelation 2:9–10 <u>I know your tribulation and your poverty (but you are rich)</u>... ¹⁰ <u>Do not fear what you are about to</u> <u>suffer</u>. Behold, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have tribulation. <u>Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life</u>. (ESV)

Revelation 2:14–15 <u>You have some there who hold to the teaching of Balaam</u>, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the people of Israel, so that they would eat food sacrificed to idols and engage in sexual immorality. ¹⁵ So you also have some who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans. (NRSV)

4. By ______ to what ______.

Revelation 2:19–25 *I know your deeds, your love and faith, your service and perseverance, and that <u>you are now</u> <u>doing more than you did at first</u>. ²⁰ Nevertheless... <u>you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who... misleads my</u> <u>servants</u>... ²¹ I have given her time to repent of her immorality, but she is unwilling. ²² So I will cast her on a bed of suffering... ²³ Then <u>all the churches will know that I am he who searches hearts and minds</u>... ²⁴ 'I will not impose any other burden on you, ²⁵ except to <u>hold on to what you have until I come</u>.' (NIV)*

5. By ______ what is ______.

Revelation 3:1–3 I know what you have done. <u>You are known for being alive, but you are dead</u>. ² Be alert, and strengthen the things that are left which are about to die. I have found that <u>what you are doing has not been</u> <u>completed</u> in the sight of my God. ³ So remember what you received and heard. <u>Obey, and change the way you</u> <u>think and act</u>. (GW)

6. By ______ to the end.

Revelation 3:10 Since <u>you have kept my command to endure patiently</u>. I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come on the whole world to test the inhabitants of the earth. (NIV)

7. By opening _______ when ______.

Revelation 3:15–17, 19–20 *I know your works; <u>you are neither cold nor hot</u>. <i>I wish that you were either cold or* hot. ¹⁶ So, because you are lukewarm and neither cold nor hot, I am about to spit you out of my mouth. ¹⁷ For you say, 'I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing.' <u>You do not realize that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind,</u> <u>and naked</u>... ¹⁹ I reprove and discipline those whom I love. Be earnest, therefore, and repent. ²⁰ Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; <u>if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in and eat with you, and you with me</u>. The Covenant Renewal


