## Have you ever prayed a prayer that was not answered?

#### The Power of Authentic Prayer:

#### I. Jesus prayed an authentic prayer.

Luke 22:39–42 And He came out and proceeded as was His custom to the Mount of Olives; and the disciples also followed Him. <sup>40</sup>When He arrived at the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation." <sup>41</sup>And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and He knelt down and began to pray, <sup>42</sup> saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me; yet not My will, but Yours be done." (NASB)

- The disciples asked Jesus to teach them how to pray. (Matthew 6, Luke 11)
   Jesus taught His disciples to pray for their enemies. (Matthew 5:44)
- Jesus taught His disciples not to make a show of their prayers, but to pray in secret to God who is in secret.
- Jesus went to the mountains to pray. (Mark 4:46, Luke 6:12, etc.)
  Jesus prayed the High Priestly Prayer. (John 17)
  Jesus prayed with the little children. (Matthew 19:13)

### II. The Father heard Jesus' prayer.

**Luke 22:43–46** <u>Now an angel from heaven appeared to Him, strengthening Him</u>. <sup>44</sup> And being in agony He was praying very fervently; and His sweat became like drops of blood, falling down upon the ground. <sup>45</sup> When He rose from prayer, He came to the disciples and found them sleeping from sorrow, <sup>46</sup> and said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Get up and pray that you may not enter into temptation." (NASB)

### III. The Father answered Jesus' prayer, but not the way Jesus wanted.

Luke 22:47–51 While He was still speaking, behold, a crowd came, and the one called Judas, one of the twelve, was preceding them; and he approached Jesus to kiss Him. <sup>48</sup> But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?" <sup>49</sup> When those who were around Him saw what was going to happen, they said, "Lord, shall we strike with the sword?" <sup>50</sup> And one of them struck the slave of the high priest and cut off his right ear. <sup>51</sup> But Jesus answered and said, "Stop! No more of this." And He touched his ear and healed him. (NASB)
