The Foundations of Biblical Evangelism

The Mission: God's ultimate purpose for evangelism is to glorify Himself.

- A. God's ultimate purpose in everything is to glorify Himself.
- B. Salvation accomplishes God's mission to bring Himself glory.
- C. Evangelism exists because worship does not.



The Motivation: Believers are motivated by love for God.

- A. If we love God, we will obey Him.
 - 1. Love for God expresses itself in obedience, of which evangelism is a part.
 - 2. Love for God expresses itself in love toward others.
- B. If we obey Him, we will glorify Him.



The Message: The God-centered gospel presentation emphasizes God's glory and man's sinfulness.

- A. The God-centered message proclaims God's holiness.
- B. The God-centered message reveals man's sinful condition.
- C. The God-centered message declares Christ as Savior and Lord.



The Message: The God-centered gospel presentation emphasizes God's glory and man's sinfulness.

D. The God-centered message calls sinners to repent and believe in Christ.

E. The God-centered message proclaims God Himself as the great end of the gospel.

1. God's chief end in salvation is His own glory.
2. The sinner's greatest benefit in salvation is God Himself.



The Method: We evangelize with a transformed lifestyle and a biblical presentation.

- A. Live a transformed life.
- B. Maintain a lifestyle of prayer.
- C. Present the gospel with wisdom and innocence.
- D. Rely upon Scripture as the only authority.

The Gospel Presentation, Part 1:

I. God

A. God is Creator and Owner of everything.

1. The Person of God Revealed in Creation.
2. The Law of God Revealed in the Conscience.
 - The conscience is an alarm system.
 - The conscience activates based on the level of good that it knows.
 - The conscience can be programmed.

B. God is perfectly holy.

C. God requires perfect obedience to His law.

- B. The consequence for sin is separation from God.
