Phil 2:15-16 - we are to be children without blemish in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation... we are to shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life.

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Matt 5:16 - Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.
