Acts 14:23 - And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, with prayer and fasting, they committed them to the Lord in whom they believed.

Titus 1:15 - ...appoint elders in every town...

1 Peter 5:1-2 - I exhort the elders among you...shepherd the flock of God that is your charge...

1 Tim. 5:17 - Let the elders who rule well be considered worth of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.

- poimen 'pastor; shepherd' Eph 4:1; Acts 20:28
- episkopos 'overseer' Acts 20:28; 1 Tim 3:1-2

1 Pet 5:1-2 - ...I exhort the elders [presbuteros] among you, as your fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed, shepherd [poimaino] the flock of God among you exercising oversight [episkopeo] not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to the will of God.

- 1 Tim 2:12 I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man...
