BOLD FOR THE GOSPEL Romans 1:16-17

Rom 1:16 - For I am not ashamed of the gospel...

= a litotes

He glories in the gospel and counts it a high honor to proclaim it.

- = he was NOT FEARFUL of proclaiming the truth.
- 2 Tim 1:8, 12 8 Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord ... but join with me in suffering for the gospel.... 12 For this reason I also suffer these things, but I am not ashamed...

TWO REASONS Paul was so *confident* and *bold* in proclaiming the truth...and why he was so *eager* to do so...

I. BECAUSE OF WHAT IT IS

16...for it is the power of God for salvation...

1 Cor 1:18 - ... the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

1 Cor 2:4-5 - 4 and my message and my preaching were not in persuasive words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, 5 so that your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but on the power of God.

TWO REASONS Paul was so *confident* and *bold* in proclaiming the truth...

Rom 4:16 - For this reason it is by faith...so that the promise will be guaranteed to all the descendants...also to those who are of the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all...

Rom 4:20–21 - 20...with respect to the promise of God, he did not waver in unbelief but grew strong in faith...21 and being fully assured that what God had promised, He was able also to perform.

Luke 5:32 - I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance.

I. BECAUSE OF WHAT IT IS

16...to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Rom 3:9 - ...both Jews and Greeks are all under sin...

Rom 3:29 - Or is God the God of Jews only? Is He not the God of Gentiles also? Yes, of Gentiles

Rom 9:24 - even us, whom He also called, not from among Jews only, but also from among Gentiles.

17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

Hebrew – righteousness = saddiq - in the right...doing what is right

wicked = rasa - in the wrong...doing what is wrong

Both are FORENSIC ideas - a LEGAL STATUS

17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

1 – THE SAVING ACTIVITY OF GOD

POSITIVE ASPECT

Psa 98:2 - The LORD has made known His <u>salvation</u>; He has revealed His <u>righteousness</u>...

Isa 61:10 - ... He has clothed me with garments of <u>salvation</u>, He has wrapped me with a robe of <u>righteousness</u>...

17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

1 – THE SAVING ACTIVITY OF GOD

In contrast to the NEGATIVE ASPECT:

Psa 50:6 — ... the heavens declare His <u>righteousness</u>, for God Himself is <u>judge</u>.

v 18 – the revelation of God's wrath.

- 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

DOCTRINE OF JUSITFICATION

God credits – or IMPUTES – to the repentant, believing sinner the *righteousness* of Christ.

- 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

- 2 THE STATUS GIVEN BY GOD

Rom 5:17 - ... those who receive... the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Phil 3:9 – (Paul said he did not have) a righteousness of (his own) derived from the Law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith...

17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed...

The *righteousness of God* = the <u>intervening action</u> by God, by which He brings people into a new <u>position</u> of a right standing before Him.

DORIANI – The gospel cure is not that we do what we can, but that God does what we cannot.

17...from faith to faith...

NOTHING BUT FAITH can put us into a right relationship with God.

(Habakkuk 2:4)

17...as it is written, "But the righteous man shall live by faith."

Also in *Gal 3:11...* and *Heb 10:38*

Habakkuk - *faith* = *steadfastness* in a firm belief in God and His word.

Romans = He who is righteous by faith, shall live.

#1 – The Duty to Proclaim the Gospel

2 Cor 5:20 - ... we are ambassadors for Christ...

1 Cor 1:21 - ... God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message <u>preached</u> to save those who believe.

preach = kerusso - to herald...proclaim

Matt 28:19 - Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations...
