God chooses Jacob over Esau • Genesis 25:21–34; 27:1–28:5

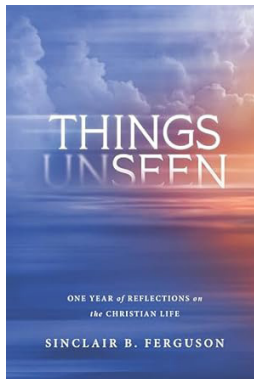
Principle: God sovereignly chooses whomever He wants to accomplish His purposes.
