

#### Let's Study Romans



The Epistle to the Romans is both a highly personal letter and an authoritative theological treatise, inspired by the Holy Spirit and penned by the Apostle Paul.

Paul himself, having been changed from the persecutor Saul into an ambassador for Christ, is evidence of the saving and transforming power of God that he expounds in his letter. He anticipates the questions of Christians examining their faith throughout the ages, and rebuts errors and heresies with which we still grapple today.

Sinclair Ferguson meditates on the grace and tenderness of God which Paul so plainly and boldly proclaims, and painstakingly unravels the most complex passages.

Let's Study Romans is suitable for individual or group use and includes a Study Guide to aid readers in grasping and retaining the logical progression of Paul's thought.



#### **Unveiling the Cross**

by W. Ross Blackburn

In Unveiling the Cross, Ross Blackburn examines the Isaiah 6 vision of the Lord, 'high and lifted up,' in the light of New Testament revelation. Why did this encounter affect the prophet's life so radically? What did he understand of the One on the throne? How is this 'Day of Atonement' scene connected to other heavenly visions in the Bible? In discussing these questions, the author discourses with two classic works, Hugh Martin's The Atonement, and Sinclair B. Ferguson's The Whole Christ. His treatment of Scripture – from the origin of 'uncleanness' in Genesis to the Lamb on the throne in Revelation – is incisive and masterful. Each page magnifies the Christ of the cross, the Christ of the throne, and the Christ who intercedes for his people. It is impossible to encounter this Lord of Hosts and remain unchanged.
