The Son of Man anticipates His death • Luke 22:7–20, 39–46

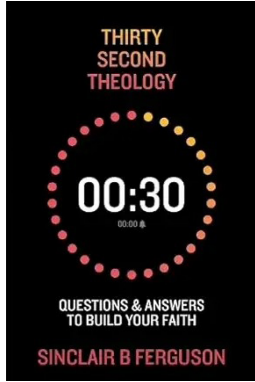
Principle: Jesus is the sacrificial Lamb of God.

Apply: By thanking God for sending His Son to be the perfect sacrifice for sin.

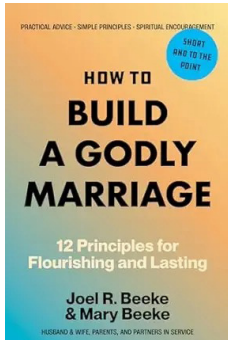
