God punishes Solomon • 1 Kings 11:1-43

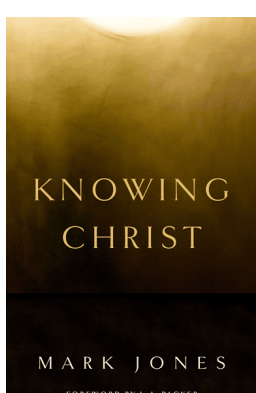
Principle: We should love God wholeheartedly.

Apply: By praying for the Lord's deliverance from temptation.

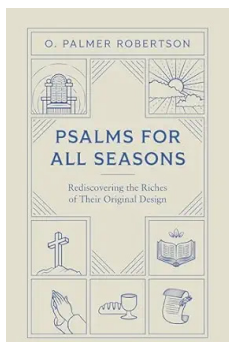
This Week: As a family, read 1 Kings 11:1-43.

Knowing Christ by Mark Jones

The Puritans loved the Bible, and dug into it in depth. Also, they loved the Lord Jesus, who is of course the Bible's focal figure; they circled round him, centred on him, studied minutely all that Scripture had to say about him, and constantly, conscientiously, exalted him in their preaching, praises, and prayers. Mark Jones, an established expert on many aspects of Puritan thought, also loves the Bible and its Christ, and the Puritans as expositors of both; and out of this triune love he has written a memorable unpacking of the truth about the Saviour according to the classic Reformed tradition, and the Puritans supremely. *Knowing Christ* is a book calculated to enrich our twenty-first-century souls, and one that it is an honour to introduce.



Psalms for All Seasons by O. Palmer Robertson

O. Palmer Robertson here examines twenty-five psalms, reflecting the variety of messages and structures found across the entire Book of Psalms. The author argues that originally the Psalms were intended to be used with interactive congregational responses and his translations reflect this understanding.

This book aims to help congregations rediscover the riches of the Psalms in their fullness, that the full-orbed testimony of the Psalter, as it touches every experience of weal and woe in the life of God's people, may again find a voice in the current worship of the church.
