God punishes Judah • 2 Kings 21:1-18; 24:1-25:30

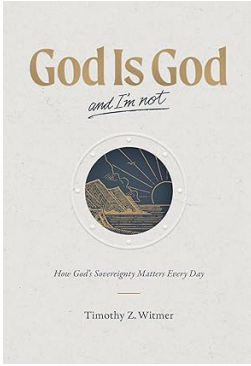
Principle: God hates and punishes all sin.

This Week: As a family, read 2 Kings 21:1-18; 24:1-25:30.

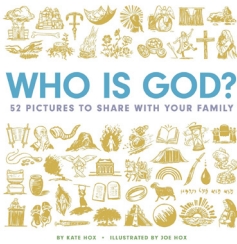
