Calvary has funds available to provide scholarships for the education of church workers. These funds are available largely as a result of the generosity of the Wessler family through the endowed Wessler Scholarship Fund. For the coming school year Calvary is providing support to four students that are alums of Lutheran High School and currently enrolled in LCMS universities. Paige Taylor (Teaching) and Paige Mielke (Youth and Family Ministry) are both enrolled at Concordia University Wisconsin. Grace King (Teaching) is enrolled at Concordia University Chicago and Jacob Reid (Parish Pastor Ministry) is enrolled at Concordia Theological Seminary. These students also received scholarships from Calvary in the prior school year.
