Small Group Guide

Warm-up Question: (Choose one, make up your own, or skip this part altogether, depending upon the nature of your group.)

1. What's one unexpected place or situation where you've had the chance to share your faith or talk about Jesus?
2. If you could perform any miraculous sign mentioned in the Bible, which one would it be and why?

Read the following passage: Mark 16:15-18

This past Sunday, Pastor Shaddy Soliman delivered a message based on Mark 16:15-18, challenging the church to take seriously their call to preach the gospel wherever God has placed them. He emphasized that while signs and wonders may follow, believers should not be focused on chasing after them. Instead, their primary responsibility is to be obedient in sharing the good news. Pastor Shaddy also shared personal testimonies of how simply showing up and doing what God has called him to do has led to transformative moments in the lives of others, highlighting the power of faithful obedience.

Questions for Discussion (Choose several that are relevant for your group):

1. In Mark 16:15-18, Jesus calls us to "go into all the world and preach the gospel." What does this command look like in your everyday life?
2. Shaddy mentioned that signs and wonders may follow when we preach the gospel, but they shouldn't be our focus. How do we guard our hearts against chasing after signs rather than being obedient to God's call?
3. How has God uniquely placed you in your current circumstances to share the gospel? What specific opportunities do you see around you?
4. Shaddy shared testimonies of transformation through simple acts of obedience. Have you ever experienced a moment when God moved powerfully through your obedience? Share with the group.
5. What fears or obstacles hold you back from sharing the gospel with others? How can the group support you in overcoming these challenges?
6. How can we cultivate a heart of obedience to God's call in a world that often encourages us to seek visible results?
7. In what ways do you think signs and wonders serve as confirmation of God's presence and power, and how should we respond when we don't see them immediately?

8 How can we, as a small group, encourage one another to stay committed to sharing the gospel regularly in our communities? What practical steps can we take this week?
