



USE THESE QUESTIONS AND RESOURCES TO HELP YOU PROCESS THE MESSAGE IN YOUR PERSONAL STUDY TIME OR WITH YOUR GROUP.

Message Recap: Jesus' first miracle was to turn water into wine, which had never been done before. God still wants to do something new in your life too! Are you ready for new wine?

» Main Points

- When the wine was gone, the miracles started.
- Invite him - to invite God into your life, you must make room for him.
- Involve him - God can take ordinary things and do something extraordinary.
- Invoke him - when we serve with God, we get to participate in the process.

» Getting Started

- Talk about a time you ran out of something that you were expected to have.

» Observation

- Read and reflect on [John 2:1-11: 1:46-48](#)
- What are your initial reactions to these passages? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?

reachout

- This time of year is a great chance to meet some new neighbors. Look for people when they are out shoveling their driveways, walking their dog, or getting their mail. If you don't know them introduce yourself, if they're shoveling, help.

growdeep

- How have you invited God into every area of your life? What does it look like to invite him into the empty places in your life?
- Where do you go when things in your life are running low? Who or where do you turn to when you are anxious, worried, or hopeless?
- Jesus doesn't point to what we need. He points to what we have. What ordinary thing do you have that God can do something extraordinary with?
- What have you run out of, or what are you afraid of running out of? Joy, wisdom, peace, ideas?

partner with families

- Set up a meal to cook as a family this week, and as you prepare and gather items for the meal, leave out something important. When you reach that step, work together as a family to develop a new solution. This will work with meal prep, but it's a little harder with baking as that's more of a science. When you "discover" the missing item, use it as a conversation connection to this week's message. Ask your family members where in their lives God can take something from ordinary to extraordinary.

» Next Steps and Prayer

- Where do you need God to do something new in your life?
- Close by inviting Jesus into your life so you can involve and invoke him with the ordinary parts of your life.
