Observation

- Read and reflect on Genesis 1:1.26-28: John 15:4-11: Psalm 46:1.10: Ephesians 3:20
- What are your initial reactions to these passages? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses?



• Where are the places in your life where passion, talent, and need intersect? How can you lean into those spaces this week?



- When you consider the four postures we try to relate to God Work Under God, Work Over God, Work From God, Work
