Week Four | End Game

USE THESE QUESTIONS AND RESOURCES TO HELP YOU PROCESS THE MESSAGE IN YOUR PERSONAL STUDY TIME OR WITH YOUR GROUP.

Message Recap: It's possible to be a good person without doing good for another person, but that's not good for anybody.

Main Points

- Goodness needs to extend beyond us.
- Our end game should be to demonstrate the love of God by leveraging our integrity for the sake of others.

Setting Started

- What is typically your motivation when it comes to doing something good for someone else?
- What do you think gets in the way of making ourselves readily available to those around us?

> Observation

- Read and reflect on Proverbs 11:3; Matthew 21:46; 22:16–17, 34–39; Galatians 5:13–14; Luke 18:21–22
- What are your initial reactions to these passages? What do you find challenging? Are you encouraged by any of these verses? Why?



• Being a person of integrity means trying to do good for the people around you. You try to show the love of God to everyone around you. This week, pray that God would give you the integrity not just to be good for goodness' sake but also to love the people close to you who are far from God.



- If you consider yourself a good person, could you prove it based on the good things you do, or would it be based on the "bad" things you don't do?
- Which of the following do you most relate to?
 - Saving is easier than giving.
 - Discipline is easier than compassion.
 - Being good may be a substitute for doing good.
- Where have you resisted allowing integrity to guide you beyond you because it's uncomfortable for you? How can you shift your mindset to live a life of integrity?



• This week, pick 2-3 families in your circle and write them a card of encouragement as a family. Be specific with your encouragement, and tell them how you'll pray for them this week. Then, as a family, take time to pray for those families each day.

- What practical way can you put love into action for someone else this week?
- Close by praying that integrity would be your guide, even if it costs you.
