

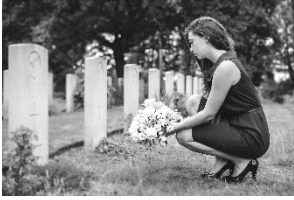
Sunday AM Sermon – May 12, 2024
