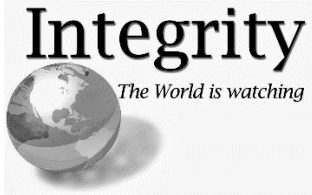


Sunday AM Sermon – August 4, 2024
