Some study methods have been utilized in Scotland but I am convinced that the SIBI will be of a great benefit, we are keeping in prayer as we prepare to talk.


Baptism Jamie


Jamie second from the left standing next to our son Bradley directly left, gave his life to christ.

New congregation in Stoke on trent




Praise God, It begins, the city of stoke now has the first body of Christ. The congregation is a 40 minute drive from Leicester and 30 minutes from Derby.
