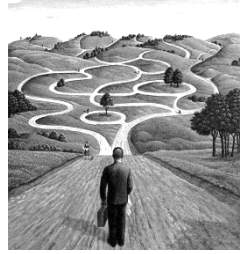


Sunday AM Sermon – January 12, 2025

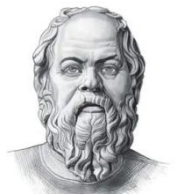
